A U.S.G.A. standard course, it provides a challenging layout with excellent ocean views and tropical landscaping and boasts the largest number of professional staff on any Bermuda course.

Port Royal Golf Club

At this renowned course you'll find the best-known and most talked about golf holes anywhere on the planet: the famous par three 16th hole. The Course, a product of the fertile imagination of Robert Trent Jones, rolls along the cliffs overlooking the South Shore. Elevated tees and holes with distinctive characteristics make Port Royal a challenging course for even the most experienced golfer.

Ocean View Golf Course

This nine-hole, 18 tee course offers magnificent views of Bermuda's North Shore. A pond lurks ominously before the green on the par-3 9th making club selection crucial, particularly when strong winds blow in from the Atlantic. Opened in 1922, Riddell's Bay Golf & Country Club is the oldest and one of the most exclusive clubs on the island. Winding along a peninsula, the course's tight fairways and narrow greens offer a magnificently challenging level of play, and breathtaking ocean vistas create a spectacular backdrop for your game.

St. George's Golf Course

Situated near the historic town of St. George, this Robert Trent Jones, Sr. design offers breathtaking Pebble Beach style holes around the point of St. George's Fort. Enjoy beautiful, panoramic views of the horizon — particularly at sunset. St. George's is one of the shortest courses on the island, and a helpful breeze tempts many players to forego the fairway and head straight for the green.
